

CLASS LIST

1. Dash for Cash

Riders Race down, and around one barrel, and back 'home' again. This would be fun as a 'true' dash-for-cash. Money on top of barrel. (loonie/toonie) rider`s choice to race for time and a win, or stop and grab money.

- Youth 12 and Under
- Youth 13-18
- Novice horse or novice rider

2. Flag Race

Riders ride to one barrel, pick up stick out of barrel, ride down to a second barrel in line. They ride around that barrel, and then bring the stick back to the first barrel, and put the stick back in barrel while mounted. Straight run, or figure-8 allowed. Optional Rag-toss for youth

3. Barrel Race

Ride around 3 barrels in what is known as a 'Cloverleaf' pattern. Riders may use either left hand, or right hand barrel first. Riders must enter and exit ring at a walk.

4. Mini-Poles (pole weaving)

Riders will move 'in and out' of THREE poles set up in a line. The start and finish will be at the same end. Pattern will be posted.

5. Pole Bending

Riders will ride through timer to start, then race down to last pole, weave back through, then weave up through, and race straight home. Pattern will be posted. Left, or right hand start allowed.

6. Texas Speed n' Action

This is a combination class, featuring 2 poles you weave through at one end, and a 'box' formation at the other end. Riders must run through box (4 poles set square) on first pass, weave through poles, return to the box and turn around staying within the box, then weave poles again, then pass through box for a final time. Pattern will be posted.

7. Around The World

Riders will run along the outside of the arena to the end, go left along the arena, the left again along the long side. At the end, stop in a box, reverse, and race back along the arena walls to the opposite side.

8. Agility Aces

In this event, a rider rides to a specified area and dismounts. Once dismounted, they walk along 'stepping stones' (or something flat on the ground) while leading their horse. At the end of the stepping stones, they remount, and ride to the finish line. Mounting block optional in youth class.
